

Mind Mapping for Finals

A mind map is a great tool to use to help you prepare for your finals. It will help you effectively organize and connect the information you need to study and make it easier to understand and remember. Today you are going to create an individual mind map of the course content and then work with several other students to combine your ideas into a group mind map. Here are a few simple instructions on the elements of a mind map. 1. Begin with your paper in a landscape orientation. 2. Place the central theme or subject in the middle of the page. 3. Use curved lines reaching out in all directions from the center theme for the supporting ideas. 4. Use additional branches or offshoots to carry collateral information. 5. Use color and simple visuals to add interest and make information more memorable. Use your notes, text...to create a mind map of the material studied in this class.

Meet with your group and review your individual mind maps then combine your information and ideas into a group mind map on the other side of this paper.
